

- 6. Each time you scan a page, you will have the option to *Retake* it or *Continue* forward to scan another page. You will see a counter of the total number of pages successfully scanned at the bottom-right of your screen.
- **7.** When you finish scanning all pages, click the page counter at the lower-right corner.
- You will now have the option to further edit the document. When it appears correct, tap
  Save PDF to finalize the scan.



**\*Please Note:** You can submit assignments directly to CANVAS through the *Adobe Scan* app. This is only possible if you have the CANVAS app downloaded to your device (it is available in the App Store).

## Instructions:

- 1. Scan a document with the Adobe Scan app.
- 2. Tap *Share*. 🖞
- 3. Tap Share a Copy.
- 4. You will see a row of your app icons. Scroll through them until you find the CANVAS icon.
- 5. Choose the correct class name and assignment.
- 6. Tap *Submit*.

\*<u>Please note</u>: There are many compatible apps that you will see when you tap *Share*. For example, you can access Mail, Messages, Chrome, AirDrop, Kindle, Zoom, Snap Chat, and more.

## **Detailed App Instructions**

- 1. Open Adobe Scan.
- 2. Tap the settings icon.
- 3. Tap *Help*.
- 4. Tap *Site* and choose a topic from the drop-down menu.
